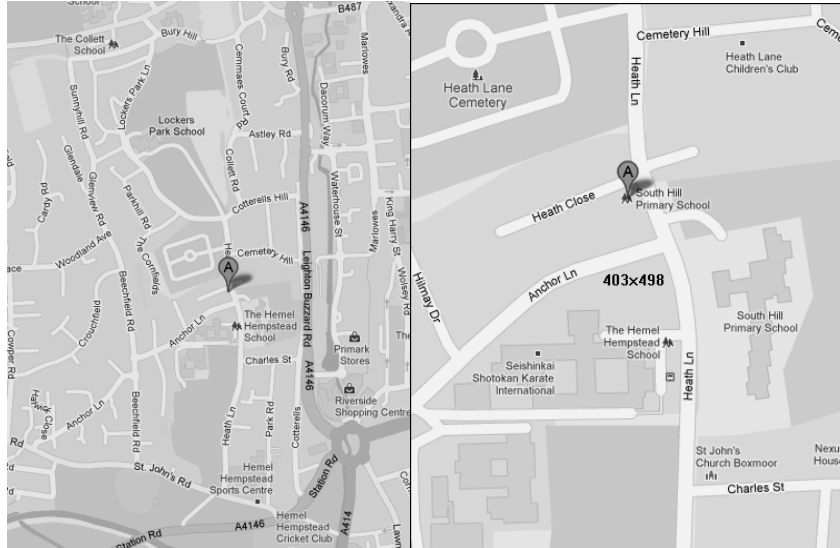


春节快乐 - 龙年春节晚会
